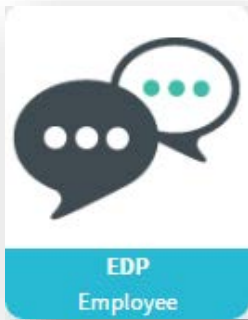
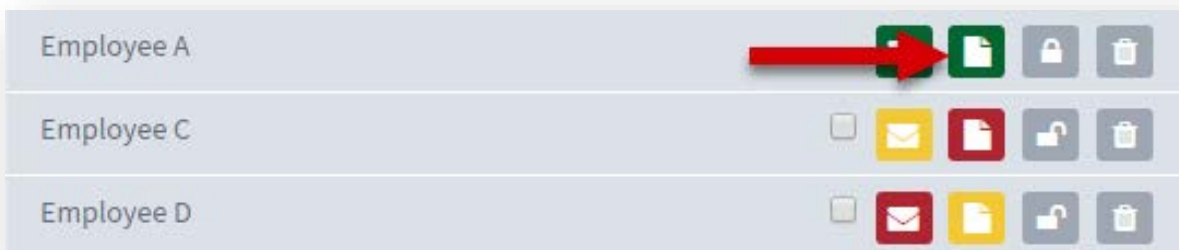


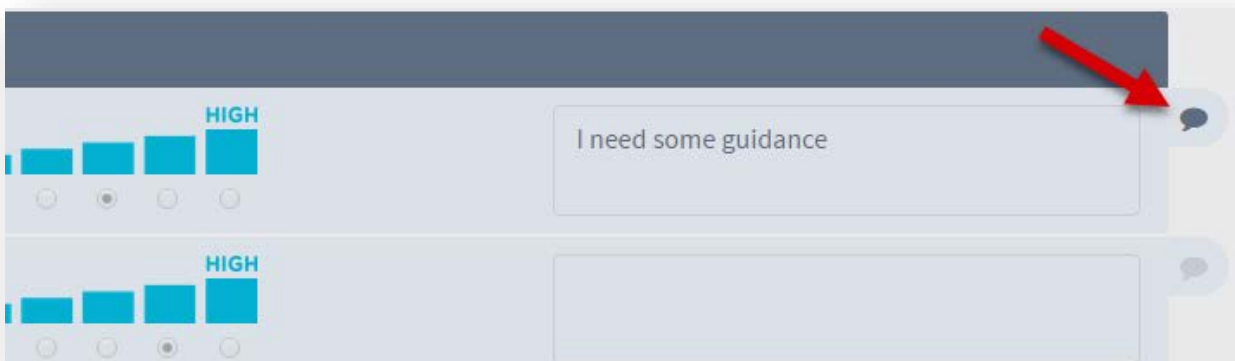
## EDP follow-up interviews



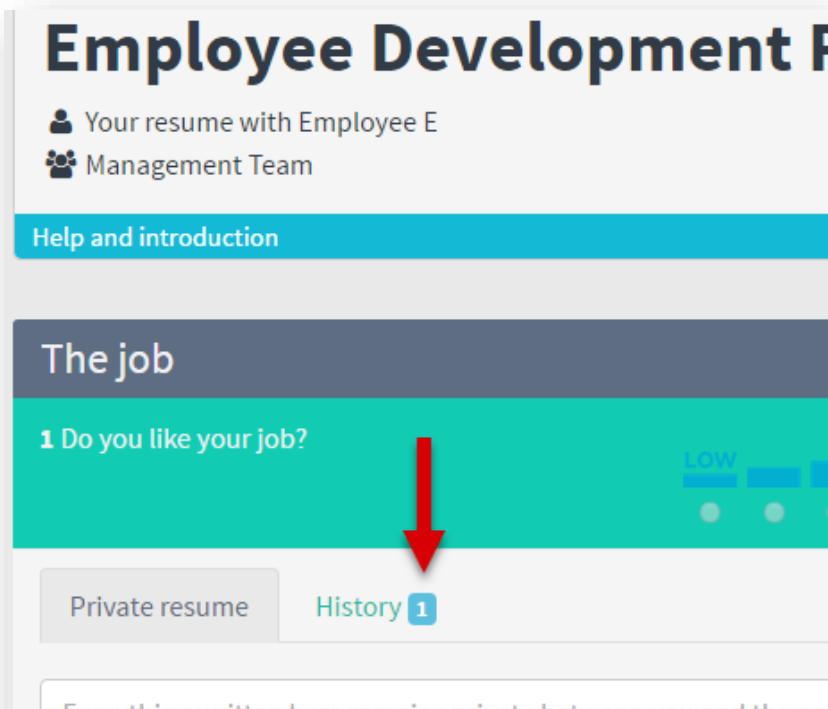
Throughout the year – right up to the point when you open up a new EDP round - it is possible to do follow-up interviews.



1. When you have completed a resume, you can still go have a look at the finished sheet (red arrow).



2. In the completed form, you can see where a resume has been written. The bubble will have turned dark (red arrow). Following this, it is possible to do short follow-up interviews during the course of the year. Click the tab with the question, and new fields will be available for you to write your resume in – and you can create new tasks.



3. Whatever you wrote in the previous resume is available under 'History'. Once you have performed the follow-up interview, and created new tasks/agreements as needed, you once again complete the resume at the bottom of the page, and the employee will receive the new resume.
